

This document is the official record of Board action and Committee reports for the quarterly meeting of the National Assessment Governing Board on March 3-5, 2011 in Miami, FL.

In the materials attached, the resolutions adopted have been designated as action items. They are as follows:

- Approval with changes of test items in reading and mathematics for the National Assessment of Educational Progress (NAEP) Long-Term Trend assessments. This action was taken by the Assessment Development Committee under a standing delegation of authority from the full Board. Changes and deletions have been transmitted in writing to the National Center for Education Statistics (NCES).
- A delegation of authority from the full Board to the Reporting and Dissemination Committee to approve release plans for five upcoming NAEP reports: Civics 2010, U.S. History 2010, Geography 2010, Mega-States, and Hispanic-White Achievement Gaps 2009.

Members of the Reporting and Dissemination Committee made a number of comments on review procedures for NAEP Report Cards, which are summarized in the Committee report.

The Board appreciates the clear and helpful presentations made at the meeting by NCES staff and NAEP contractors. The Board welcomes Jack Buckley as the newlyconfirmed Commissioner of Education Statistics, and looks forward to a pleasant and productive working relationship.
