Dear Board Member,

We are sending you the agenda and briefing materials for the August 1-3 meeting of the National Assessment Governing Board. The meeting will be in Baltimore at the Royal Sonesta Harbor Court Hotel, 550 Light Street, at the Inner Harbor. Board member Andrés Alonso, former CEO of the Baltimore City Public Schools, will be our local host. We appreciate his help in making arrangements.

The Board's Assessment Development Committee will meet at 8:00 a.m. on Thursday, followed by the Ad Hoc Committee on NAEP Background Information at 2:00 p.m. This will be the final meeting of the Ad Hoc Committee, which will present its recommendations to the full Board on Friday afternoon. The Executive Committee will meet at its usual time on Thursday at 4:30 p.m. All members are encouraged to attend the Executive Committee session, which will include an important NAEP budget discussion and action on the schedule of assessments.

At the start of Friday's general session we will hear from Lillian Lowery, Maryland State Superintendent of Schools, who has served in that post for the past year after four years as Delaware Secretary of Education. Andrés Alonso will also deliver welcoming remarks. After the standing committees meet Friday morning, the Board will receive a closed briefing from NCES Associate Commissioner Peggy Carr on national and state results from the 2013 NAEP assessments in reading and mathematics at fourth and eighth grades.

In the afternoon Terry Holliday will present the Ad Hoc Committee's final report. Next there will be a question and answer session with representatives of the two Common Core State Assessment Consortia, Jeff Nellhaus, of PARCC, and Joe Willhoft, of Smarter Balanced. Then the Board will have a policy discussion on interpreting NAEP results using preparedness research findings in the Nation's Report Card for the 2013 grade 12 assessments in mathematics and reading. Former Mississippi Governor Ronnie Musgrove, chair of the NAEP 12th Grade Preparedness Commission, will address the Board during this session.

On Saturday morning the Inside NAEP presentation, by James Deaton of NCES, will describe how the non-cognitive or background questions are developed and used in NAEP. Next on the agenda is a Board discussion session on proposed follow-up to some of the "blue sky" recommendations from the May meeting. Then the Board will consider the revised Policy Statement on the Conduct and Reporting of NAEP and hear parting remarks from member Alan Friedman, who is leaving the Board after serving two four-year terms.

This promises to be a busy and interesting meeting. If you need further assistance in any of your preparations, please let us know how we can help.
