Dear Board Member,

We are pleased to provide the agenda and briefing materials for the November 17-19, 2016 meeting of the National Assessment Governing Board. The meeting will be held at the Sheraton Pentagon City, located at 900 South Orme Street, Arlington, Virginia.

The Assessment Development Committee will meet on Thursday afternoon to review NAEP items. The Executive Committee will meet at its usual time on Thursday evening to discuss and take action on the Strategic Vision, hear about the evaluation of NAEP achievement levels, as well as discuss plans related to Long-Term Trend. The Executive Committee meeting will conclude with a closed session briefing on the NAEP research grants program. All Board members are encouraged to attend the Executive Committee meeting.

On Friday morning, the Board meeting will commence with remarks from Chair Terry Mazany. We will welcome Secretary John B. King, Jr. who will address the Board and administer the oath of office to our new and reappointed members. Following the standard reports on Governing Board and NCES activities, the Committees will meet at their usual time. Friday's working lunch session will be closed for a briefing and discussion on the embargoed 2015 National Indian Education Study. Also in closed session, NCES will present on the process data available from NAEP's digital-based assessments. Then the Board will discuss and take action on the Strategic Vision. Finally, on Friday afternoon, Board members will receive their annual ethics briefing.

Early Saturday morning, the Nominations Committee will convene in closed session. The Board will receive a briefing led by Chris Edley, Chair of the evaluation panel of NAEP's achievement levels for mathematics and reading, on the panel's final report and recommendations. This session is tentatively planned to occur in closed session as the evaluation report has not yet been published. The Board will then receive the Committee Reports and take action on the delegation of authority for our response to the achievement levels evaluation and the 2016 NAEP Arts Report Card release plan. The Board's meeting will conclude on Saturday with a session led by Rebecca Gagnon and Joseph O'Keefe on the draft Governing Board guidelines for releasing, reporting, and disseminating NAEP results.

I would be remiss to not mention that this will be our final meeting with Mary Crovo serving as Deputy Executive Director. She has requested no formal event to honor the occasion of her retirement, but we will look forward to our last Friday night dinner with her. If you need further assistance in your preparations for the Board meeting, please let us know how we can help. I wish you safe travels and will see you soon.
